

SAMSON PROFILE

Judges 16:15-22

Father: Manoah (Judges 13:2)

Mother: Anonymous she is barren. Prophecy of pregnancy

given by angelic visitation

Tribe: <u>Dan</u> (Judges 13:2)

Nazarite: Vow taken to set apart cannot touch dead things,

cannot drink wine, cannot cut hair (Judges 13:4&5,

Numbers 6)

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Judges 16:15-22

Social Status: Last judge of Israel

Purpose: Samson is to be the military leader to lead the nation of Israel against the Philistines. God has gifted him with

great physical strength. (Judges 13:5)

- Samson never lives up to the full <u>call</u> of God on his life because despite his great <u>physical</u> <u>strength</u>, he is hindered by some real <u>weaknesses</u>.
- No matter how <u>strong</u> you are in one area in your life, you will never rise above the <u>weakness</u> you suffer with in other areas of your life.
- Whatever makes you <u>weak</u> will always <u>take</u> you farther than you intended to go, <u>keep</u> you longer than you wanted to <u>stay</u> and <u>cost</u> you more than you intended to <u>pay</u>.

- I. Samson is <u>fixated</u> on feelings but not <u>focused</u> on the <u>facts</u>.
 (He's in is feelings) (Proverbs 3:5)
 - a. When you are in your <u>feelings</u> without facts, you will always make bad <u>decisions</u>
 - i. When is the last time you made a decision based on feelings?
 - ii. How long did your feelings last?
 - iii. Have you ever regretted a decision you made based on feelings alone?

- b. Greatest damage done to you in life will never be lies other people tell you. The greatest damage done to you is lies you tell yourself; a fact you ignore because of what your heart feels.
 - i. Why is it so hard to admit that sometimes it's our feelings leading us and not facts?
 - ii. What do you do when you are in your feelings?

II. His desire for Delilah is deeper than his devotion to God.

- a. When you give anything or anyone more <u>priority</u>, <u>attention</u>, <u>devotion</u> and <u>resources</u> of your life than you give to God it becomes an idol.
 - i. What do you put more energy in than you give to God?
 - ii. Have you ever been convicted that something else has take priority in your life over God?
- b. Your desire can <u>distort</u> your <u>discernment</u> when your deepest desire is not for God. (Jeremiah 29:13, Psalm 42:1, James 4:8)
 - i. What do you long for?
