





This month the Brentwood's Criminal Justice Ministry will celebrate its 25th year of participating in Project Angel Tree. The project is responsive to the needs of children who are from homes where at least one parent is incarcerated.

Angel Tree provides each child with two Christmas gifts such as toys, clothing, electronics, board games and storybooks of the birth of Christ. Over the years Brentwood's participation has increased from sponsoring 100 children to approximately 700 children annually. Brentwood's members respond each year in a phenomenal way, giving generously of their resources and time.

In prior years, our Deacons and volunteers have delivered gifts to the homes of the children. Today the Criminal Justice Ministry sponsors a Christmas Program in our Lifelong Learning Center for the children and their family.
